Report on: - "Stress Management and Universal Human Values"

We all talk about stress, it often isn't clear what stress is really about.

Many people consider stress to be something that happens to them, an event such as an injury or a job loss. Others think that stress is what happens to our body, mind, and behavior in response to an event (E.g. heart pounding, anxiety, or nail biting). While stress does involve events and our response to them, these are not the most important factors. Our thoughts about the situations in which we find ourselves are the critical factor.

When something happens to us, we automatically evaluate the situation mentally. We decide if it is threatening to us, how we need to deal with the situation, and what skills we can use. If we decide that the demands of the situation outweigh the skills we have, then we label the situation as "stressful" and react with the classic "stress response." If we decide that our coping skills outweigh the demands of the situation, then we don't see it as "stressful."



Stress can come from any situation or thought that makes you feel frustrated, angry, or anxious. Everyone sees situations differently and has different coping skills. For this reason, no two people will respond exactly the same way to a given situation.

Additionally, not all situations that are labeled “stressful” are negative. The birth of a child, being promoted at work, or moving to a new home may not be perceived as threatening. However, we may feel that situations are “stressful” because we don’t feel fully prepared to deal with them. Program started with lighting of lamp and brief introduction of guest started with speech of Hon. Principal Sir.

Session Concludes stress management is a wide spectrum of techniques and analyses aimed at controlling a person's level of stress, especially long-lasting stress, usually for the purpose of improving everyday functioning.

The Orator cited the definition of the word "stress" as given by the Oxford Dictionary which is "A state of affair involving demand on physical or mental energy" Today, with the rapid diversification of human activity, especially in the professional arena, we come face to face with numerous causes of stress and the symptoms of anxiety and depression. He also emphasized that stress, in moderate doses, is necessary in our life.

Research suggests that stress can actually increase our performance. Instead of wilting under stress, one can use it as an impetus to achieve success. Under stress the brain is emotionally and biochemically stimulated to sharpen its performance. But taking stress positively and as a Catalyst for growth requires self-motivation along with pertinent guidance. Here comes the role of Stress Management which is the amelioration of stress and especially chronic stress often for the purpose of improving everyday functioning. It was an interactive session where the students learnt to balance and relax their professional life and take stress as a performance booster and not hindrance thus "Creating Excellence



through positive competition". The key note speech was given by Mr.Pardeshi R. K.who was also the Chief Guest. Program started with lighting of lamp and brief introduction of guest started with speech of Hon. Principal Sir.

## Report on

### "Chatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Jayanti"

Adsul Technical Campus Faculty of Engineering & MBA, Chas, Ahmednagar has taken initiative to celebrate Chatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Jayanti, for all members including, staff, non- teaching staff & students.

Chatrapati Shivaji Maharaj was the founder of the Maratha Empire in western India. He was born on February 19, 1630, Shivneri Fort, Pune district, Maharashtra. He is considered to be one of the greatest warriors of his time and even today, stories of his exploits are narrated as a part of the folklore. With his valor and great administrative skills, Shivaji carved out an enclave from the declining Adilshahi sultanate of Bijapur. It eventually became the genesis of the Maratha Empire. After establishing his rule, Shivaji implemented a competent and progressive administration with the help of a disciplined military and well-established administrative set-up. Shivaji is well-known for his innovative military tactics that centered around non-conventional methods leveraging strategic factors like geography, speed, and surprise to defeat his more powerful enemies.

Over the course of his life, Shivaji engaged in both alliances and hostilities with the Mughal Empire, Sultanate of Golkonda, and Sultanate of Bijapur, as well as European colonial powers. Shivaji's military forces expanded the Maratha sphere of influence, capturing and building forts, and forming a Maratha navy. Shivaji established a competent and progressive civil rule with well-structured administrative organisations. He revived ancient Hindu political traditions and court conventions and promoted the usage of Marathi and Sanskrit, rather than Persian, in court and administration.

Shivaji's legacy was to vary by observer and time but he began to take on increased importance with the emergence of the Indian independence





movement, as many elevated him as a proto-nationalist and hero of the Hindus.<sup>[4]</sup> Particularly in Maharashtra, debates over his history and role have engendered great passion and sometimes even violence as disparate groups have sought to characterise him and his legacy.

Principal of Institute was the guest speaker for the program, addressed the students and shared some valuable experiences of shivaji maharaj's life and students were motivated by his speech. All over about 40 students were present.




